In the evolutionary phases of cellulite, clinically called "Edematous Fibrosclerotic Panniculopathy" (EFP) the intradermal therapy was mainly addressed to the treatment of edema and microcirculation.

Today, numerous pathophysiological considerations demonstrate the need to intervene also and especially on the Extra Cellular Matrix (ECM).

WHAT'S NEW ABOUT CELLULITE?

The synergy of the mix of HA+AA and an Alkaline Solution determines the physiological induction of the precise mechanisms to improve the structure of the ECM, adjusting micro circulation and reducing fibrosis.


STAGES OF CELLULITE






Stages I and II of cellulite presents an edemato – inflammatory condition of the tissue associated with hypo-oxigenation and acidosis.

Stages I and II can be treated with ATL-n Technique (Across Tension Lines needle).





The pathogenetic mechanism of late stage of cellulite is mostly related to the aging phenomena of tissues (inflamm-aging / acidosis) already degenerated in fibrosis and subsequently in sclerosis. This condition is often related to menopause when the decrease of the **hormones** is worsening the process.

Stages III and IV can be treated with Cannula and ATL-c Technique (Across Tension Lines cannula).




FOLDING LINES IN CELLULITE TREATMENT

According to studies on the "folding lines"[1], the injection rationale is to follow ideal orthogonal lines on the natural folding ones

INJECTION SCHEME:


3 Areas per side (2.5 ml per Area → 7.5 ml per leg).






STAGES I AND II OF CELLULITE






- Needle 12mm, 30G
- Needle inclination 30°
- Medium Deep Dermis
- 0.15 ml per point
- Perpendicularly to Folding Lines






- Cannula 27G and 40-50 mm or 22G and 50-70mm

Group B


14 subjects with stages III and IV cellulite
